The main focus from all of the council members was on outside equipment for lunchtime play. Because of some of the requests made during this conversation, it became apparent that Year One children were not familiar with the equipment available to them in the shed. New equipment requested included giant noughts and crosses, a see-saw, Swingball, new bikes and scooters, a sand pit with toys, a play house, a roundabout, books and writing equipment available in the quiet area, chinks, a den making kit, and a climbing frame to include slides and monkey bars. It was felt that an outdoor cupboard in the quiet area would be a good place to store items for quiet activity, such as books, pens and paper.
