

School Council Minutes – Thursday 10th November 2016

Classes represented - Lion, Tiger, Leopard, Hedgehog, Badgwe, Fox, Falcon, Kestral and Eagle.

Meeting led by Miss Daniel

Item One – Introductions

We went round the group and introduced ourselves.

Item Two – Read through the minutes of the previous meeting

We discussed what happened during the last meeting. Miss Daniel explained some of the decisions made by Mrs Brierley regarding points raised by the council.

These are as follows:

- We still need to talk about the possibility of the reinstatement of goal posts on the KS2 field. Some classes cannot at present access a football goal.
- We still need to discuss the possibility of having basketball hoops.
- Miss Daniel explained that large equipment, such as a climbing frame, was being researched by Mrs Brierley. The huge cost and difficulty of buying this kind of equipment was discussed.
- KS1 children felt that replacing the climbing frame that was removed for health and safety reasons was really important to them.
- Miss Daniel explained the impossibility of arranging a disco in time for Children in Need. Several suggestions were made for other reasons to hold a disco, such as a Star Pupil award, End of term / year treat, and Comic Relief.
- We discussed the design of a new School Council badge and a vote was taken for the most popular badge. The most votes were cast for red and shield shape.
- New folders, front pages, minutes from the last meeting and paper was handed out.
- Children in Need was discussed at length (to follow).

Item Three – Children in Need

- The council were happy to hear that we can have a non-school uniform day on which we can pay a £1 donation to wear spots, cover a Pudsey picture with spare change, and they loved the idea of a cake sale – **action** Miss Daniel to talk to Mrs Brierley about whether we can cook cakes or if we are to ask for donations.
- Council members were particularly interested in the competition element of collecting spare change in each class. They would like to know what the prize will be.
- The children who wrote to Pudsey (and Blush) were thanked – they are keen to hear back from Pudsey.
