### Kangaroo and Wallaby Class: Home learning schedule for Week Commencing 6th July 2020

This week, we will be basing our home learning activities on London, our capital city. Looking at London offers the children the opportunity to look at the features of a different environment, and begin to learn about the culturally significant places there, such as Tower Bridge, The Houses of Parliament, and The Tower of London. This week, we will continue to aim to develop being Principled and Thinkers from the Learner Profile. From the Early Years Foundation Stage, we will be exploring 'Understanding the World', and mathematical concepts such as shape, distance, money and time.

<p><b>Day 1 Monday 22nd June - Links and Activities:</b></p> <p><b>English – Watch, or read Peppa Goes to London.</b> Listening to the story, and then engaging in conversation develops children’s Communication and Language skills and is important in the Early Years Foundation Stage, and beyond at school. There are more links [on the right] to videos about London and the Thames which could spark some interesting conversations too. <b>Suggested writing</b> - imagine being able to drive a bus, like the Queen does in the Peppa Pig story. Where would you go? Write a simple sentence that begins ‘In my bus I can go...’</p> <p><b>Maths – Telling the Time.</b> Watch the ‘What’s the Time’ song video on YouTube. Focus on the o’clock times, and emphasise that the longest hand goes up to the twelve - our own arms make fantastic moving hands of a giant clock. If you have chalk, you could make a giant clock face outside and you can make the hands out of sticks. To reinforce understanding, you can highlight the important times of the day that things happen in your house, for example lunch time, and bedtime.</p> <p><b>Phonics</b> - For a whole lesson, go to the Letters and Sounds youTube link (opposite) and choose a lesson. Alternatively, choose from a Phonics activity and video from Google Classroom.</p> <p><b>Transport Phonics Activity</b> - Write out the following words for your child to be able to read:</p> <p><b>ship boat car train rocket scooter coach bus</b></p> <p>Give clues to the words and encourage your child to read and choose the correct form of transport. For example, Make sure your child knows the words that you have written before posing a question: “which type of transport would we use to get to the moon?” If they say “rocket” then you can see if they can find the word that says ‘rocket’. <p><b>Day 2 Tuesday 23rd June - Links and Activities:</b></p> <p><b>English – Watch or read Paddington at the Palace.</b> Imagine if you could visit anywhere you liked - maybe a trip to Disneyland! Discuss what you might need to take, and then encourage your child to make a list. **Maths – Make the Union Flag using shapes.**


Watch the video [link to the right], or look at the Union Jack flag. discuss the features and shapes that make up the flag - the flag is a rectangle shape, and is made up of straight lines. Some of the straight lines form the edges of triangles. Encourage your child to draw their own union jack. The Early Learning Goal for Shape, Space and Measure states ‘They explore characteristics of [everyday objects and] shapes and use mathematical language to describe them.’

**Phonics** - For a whole lesson, go to the Letters and Sounds youTube link (opposite) and choose a lesson. Alternatively, choose from a Phonics activity and video from Google Classroom.

Phonics Activity - everyone knows that Paddington Bear loves marmalade sandwiches, but what sandwiches does your child like? Encourage them to write a sentence about the sandwich they would like to eat.

Phonics Note - ‘Sandwich’ is quite a difficult word to segment, working on this one word would be a useful task and is firmly within Phase 4 Phonics.

**Day 3 Wednesday 24th June - Links and Activities:**

**English- Read or watch Paddington at the Tower.**

Design a ticket to visit the Tower of London. It will need to say ‘ticket’ and should have a price on. A picture of the Tower of London would make it more appealing.


**Maths – Make, or draw, a crown.** Ask your child to decorate the crown with different shapes: circles, rectangles / squares, triangles. This is really tricky! But the main focus is on knowing what the shapes look like, knowing how many sides they have, and whether they have straight or curved sides.

**Phonics** - For a whole lesson, go to the Letters and Sounds youTube link (opposite) and choose a lesson. Alternatively, choose from a Phonics activity and video from Google Classroom.

Phonics Activity - watch Gerdine the Giraffe learning ‘ow’ on YouTube, and then encourage your child to write as many ow words as they can. Write out this sentence: ‘Wow I can see a crown in the tower.’ and help them to read it.

<p><b>Day 4 Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June - Links and Activities:</b></p> <p><b>English</b> - Watch the YouTube video of Paddington Bear getting ready to visit the Tower of London. In the video, Mr Evans works needs an identity badge to work at the Tower of London. Encourage your child to make their own badge. They need to write their name which should start with a capital letter, and then be written in lowercase letters.</p> <p><b>Maths</b> – Paddington Bear was lucky enough to have his own 50p made. Encourage your child to make their own coin. Look at some real coins to help and notice their features - coins need the denomination, the year and the Queen’s head!</p> <p><b>Phonics</b> - For a whole lesson, go to the Letters and Sounds youTube link (opposite) and choose a lesson. Alternatively, choose from a Phonics activity and video from Google Classroom.</p> <p>Phonics activity: <b>Which word am I describing?</b> Find the following objects and label them with the words so that your child can read them: <b>coin spoon fork hat egg pin mug / cup</b> Give clues to each word with focus on the vowel sounds. For Example, which word has the ‘or’ sound in it? <p><b>Day 5 Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June - Links and Activities:</b></p> <p><b>English and Maths</b>– Watch or read Katie in London. Encourage your child to think about where they would like to visit on the planet. Use an atlas, or Google Earth, to explore. How would they get there? What type of transport would they need? Discuss the options and practicalities!</p> <p><b>Phonics</b> - For a whole lesson, go to the Letters and Sounds youTube link (opposite) and choose a lesson. Alternatively, choose from a Phonics activity and video from Google Classroom.</p> <p>Play Tricky Word / High Frequency Word Bingo on ICT Games. use the link on the right and choose the level that is appropriate for your child.
