Inquiry News

This term's Transdisciplinary Theme is **Where we are in place and time.** The central inquiry of this theme is that **Exploration leads to discoveries and may lead to new understandings.** Through this theme, the children will look at explorers and exploration through time, identify reasons for people exploring and the outcomes of this – both positive and negative. The children will also consider where exploration will take us in the future. In music, the children will compose soundscapes to journeys and in art they will look at sketching figures and forms in motion with a focus on Viking warriors.

All work will be set on a **Monday** (starting on the 9th November) and be due for completion by the **Monday** of the following week.
